

	TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTIONS
DATE	TOURNAMENT
April 19(Sat)	Roll Your Own! – New! Each 4-some has a die with them. When you finish a hole, enter all scores as usual. Then you roll the die for a Team Score. If you roll a 1 enter the first person's score on the card, a 2 enter the second person's score on the card, etc. If a 5 is rolled, take the lowest of the 4 scores. If a six is rolled, take the highest of the 4 scores. You are recording the Gross Score on the hole for the Team Score.
April 26 (Sat)	Bargain Day – New! Two free pars are given on the front nine and two free pars are given on the back nine.
May 3(Sat)	No Cinco de Mayo Tee times based on handicaps Strike Par 5's from your scorecard. Wear bright colors and your sombreros!
May 10(Sat)	Hate Em Choose three of your hated holes before the round starts write down a par on each. A stipulation that applies is that the three holes must be comprised of one par 3, one par 4 and one par 5. Played with full handicaps. At the end of the round, add up the strokes (including the three pars on your Hate 'Em holes) deduct your handicap strokes, and the low player (or group) wins.
May 17 (Sat)	Odd/Even Partners
May 24 (Sat)	Memorial Match Play Tournament Tee times based on handicaps. Prizes for each Match play winner
May 31 (Sat)	Member/Member – Team play Format??????
Jun 7 (Sat)	Maids Quarters Only Par 4 holes count. Gross and Net.
Jun 14(Sat)	Flag Tournament Each player will get certain number of strokes - the course handicap plus 2/3 of player's full handicap. You play that number of shots you and then plant your flag on the last shot you are allowed. Player who plants her flag the farthest on the course is winner.
June 21 (Sat)	President's Cup 18 hole stroke play. Net tournament.
June 28 (Sat)	Drives & Putts – New! Individual Game. Keep track of your drives in the fairway (the Short Grass!) by placing an (x) under each score if your drive was in the fairway. On par 3's you must be on the green. Also keep track of your putts. You will receive 10 pts. for each drive in the fairway and on the par 3 greens. Your putts will be subtracted from this total. In this game, more points win!!
Jul 5 (Sat)	Red, White & Blue– Tee times based on handicaps Play from Red tees on Par 5 holes Play from White tees on Par 4 holes Play from Blue tees on Par 3 holes
Jul 12 (Sat)	Bring-A-Friend Invite friends to participate in team tournament. We have several Racebrook friends that expressed interest.
Jul 19 (Sat)	Sucker in a Bucket – New! After all four players have puttied out, choose one ball to score. On the next hole, after putting out, choose one ball of the remaining three to score. On the next hole, choose one of the remaining two balls to score. For the next hole, use the player's ball you have not already

	used (that's your Sucker). Next hole, start all over again. On the 17th & 18th hole played, you can use any ball, but not the same ball twice. Variation - Count only the Sucker's Ball for the team score.
Jul 26 (Sat)	Money Ball (similar to Orange Ball with a twist) Play own game, however everyone takes rotating turn with orange ball. Colored balls will be provided by the tournament chairs and must be used for the tournament. Two scores per hole are added together for the team score. The Money Ball score MUST be used on each score plus one other lowest team score. If you lose the money ball you are out of competition. Team with lowest score at end without losing the ball is winner.
Aug 2 (Sat)	Nassau – Low net front, back and overall.
Aug 9 (Sat)	Mutt & Jeff scoring (T) Teams of two players. Tournament scoring is total net par 3's and par 5's.
Aug 16(Sat)	Club Championship - Round 1– Stroke play all flights.
Aug 17(Sun)	Club Championship – Final Round - Stroke play all flights. Rain date Aug 23/24
Aug 23 (Sat)	Blind Holes– Play own game - stroke play. Three random holes are omitted to establish final gross and net scores.
Aug 30 (Sat)	Ninety-Nine – Team tournament. (T) Teams of two; each player is responsible to score a net 9 holes of the 18-hole match. After holing out and before teeing off on the next hole, players decide which net score to take. By the end of the match, each player must have 9 net scores.
Sept 6 (Sat)	Skins -Tee times based on handicaps Foursomes agree on amount of wager. Low score wins hole, ties go to next hole.
Sept 13(Sat)	Score Minus Putts Keep your total score on your card then below your score keep track of putts on each hole. After play subtract your putts from each score posted this will show your total shots from tee to green minus putts. Winner will be determined by best score minus ½ her handicap.
Sept 20	The Snake If you 3 putt, you own the snake and subtract -1 for each hole you own snake. The only way to get rid of it is to have an opponent 3 putt. Winner is player with least negative or zero points.
Sept 27 (Sat)	Jack & Jill – Tournament format TBD – run by Pat LaZette/Suzanne Sutton
Oct 4 (Sat)	Bingo Bango Bongo First player in foursome on green gets 1 point (Bingo), Closest to pin 1 point (Bango), First in hole 1 point (Bongo) – You must remember to play in order(farthest out first).
Oct 11 (Sat)	Criss Cross Following the round, compare the scores you recorded on No. 1 and No. 10 and circle the lower of the two. Compare No. 2 and No. 11 and circle the lower of the two, and so on through No. 9 and No. 18.
Oct 19 (Sun)	Closing Day - Format to be determined
